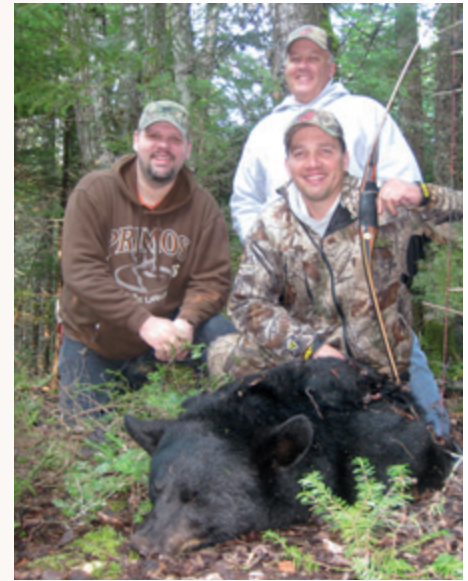

The Precision Compact Hunter "PCH" is making its debut in the 2010 catalog. We have successfully field tested the new model and feel that it is going to fill a need for many of our customers that are wanting a more compact and stable bow for treestand and ground blind hunting.

I was shooting my PCH II when I harvested my first black bear. Needless to say it was a phenomenal experience. Toby Essick and myself enjoyed our fall hunt with Squapan Mountain Outfitters in Mapleton, ME. Our guide, Tony Boucher, and his wife, Lynn, rolled out the red carpet for us. He answers the phone and fields most of the questions regarding tuning. Ray Caliendo also started in 2001. He programs the milling machines and keeps them running smoothly. The last member is Phyllis Porterfield. She started in the fall of 2005 answering the phone and filling orders; oh and Ken Beck also comes in from time to time.
